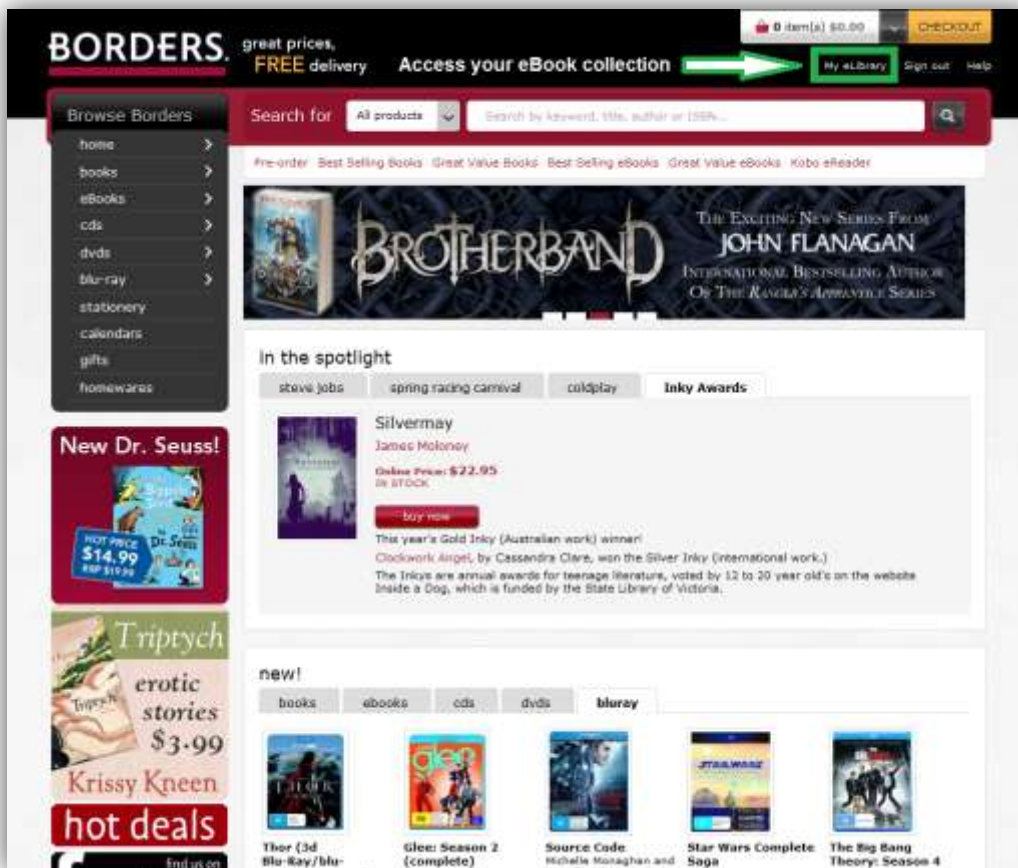


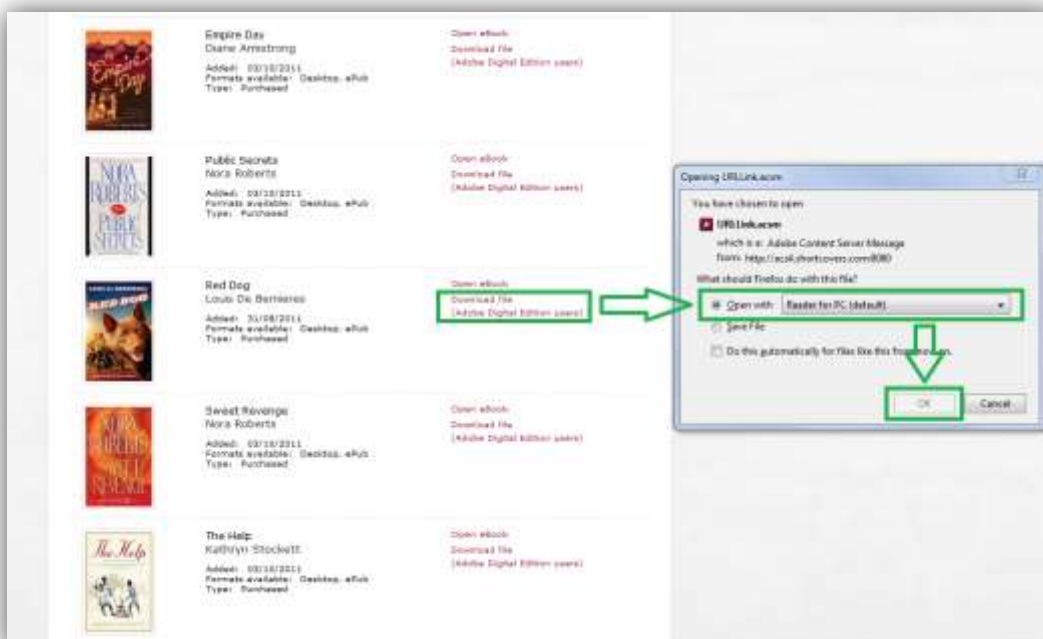
Your Sony Reader software links to the Borders store via your Internet Browser. Your Sony Reader can open ePub and PDF files, which you should download via the Sony software, Reader, for both Windows-based PCs and Apple Mac computers. To download your new eBooks purchases, simply follow the steps below.



1)

You will need to be signed-in to your Borders account to download your eBooks.

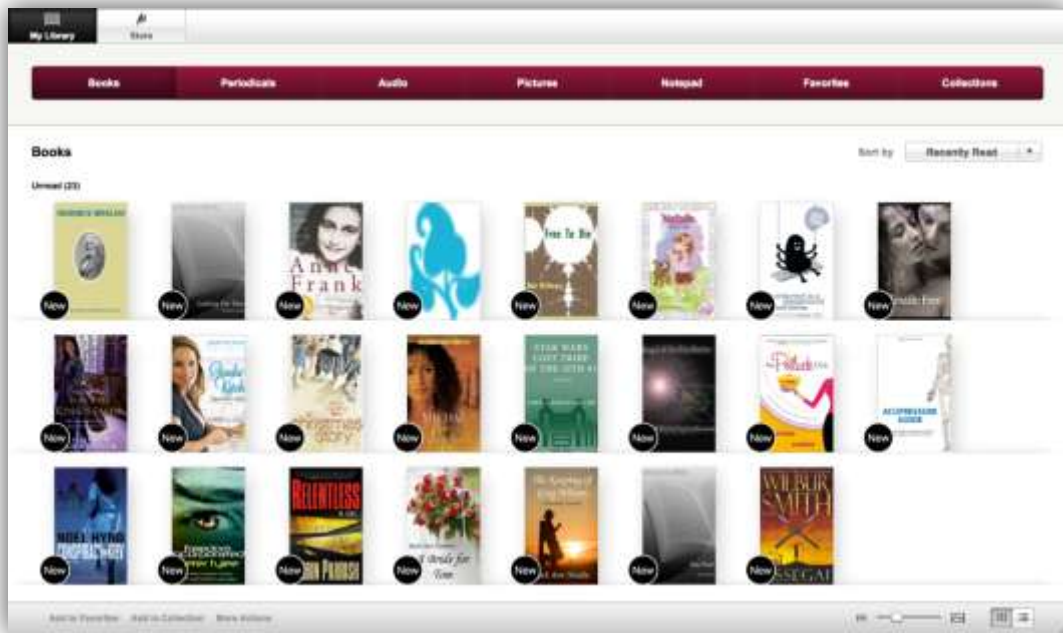
Ensure you are signed-in to your account and then access your eBook collection by clicking on 'My E-Library'.



2)

After you have clicked on 'My eLibrary' you will see the eBooks in your account displayed on your screen.

Click upon the text 'Download File (Adobe Digital Edition users)' to prompt the download window to appear.

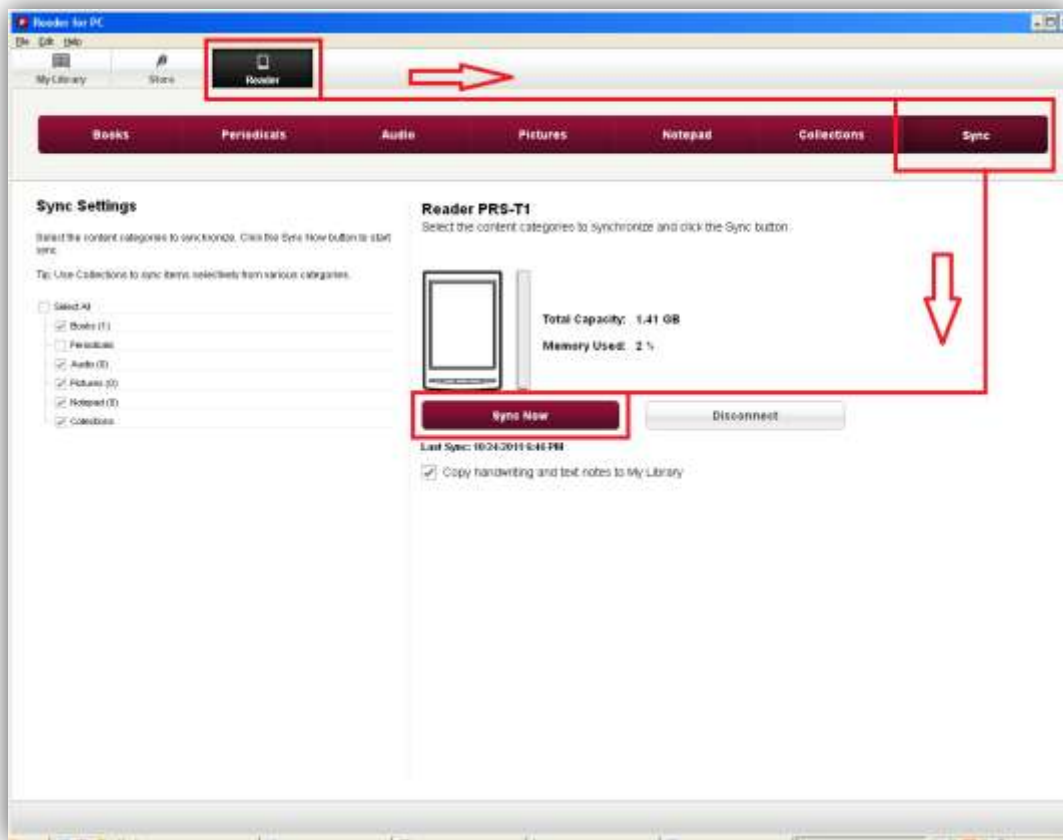


3)

Your books should now appear in Reader on your computer.

You can read the eBooks whilst at the computer, or you can transfer them to your Sony Reader.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** To move your eBooks from the computer to your Reader™ by Sony, you will need to register your device with Sony Australia. An online guide to assist with the registration process can be found [here](#).

Once your device is registered it will appear in Reader.

You can then synchronise your computer with your Reader by using the 'SYNC' function.
